Dr. Barry Rabe is the J. Ira and Nicki Harris Family Professor at the Gerald R. Ford School of Public Policy at the University of Michigan, where he directs the Center for Local, State, and Urban Policy (CLOSUP). He is also a Professor of Environmental Policy in the School of Natural Resources and Environment at Michigan, and a non-resident senior fellow in the Governance Studies Program of the Brookings Institution.

Dr. Rabe's talks draw from his research on climate policy formation and implementation in the United States and internationally, including a recent appointment as Public Policy Scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars.

Dr. Rabe will give two presentations during his visit to Virginia Tech, including a general seminar on Thursday and an undergraduate research seminar on Friday. Both events will be held at 10:30 a.m. in Fralin Auditorium.
